



The Port Terminal Railroad Association (PTRA) continues to build on their reputation as one of the most innovative users of RailConnect services.

Recently, the PTRA began to use RMI Business Intelligence as an interface to integrate the railroad with the logistics and production departments of their large customers. The reports developed measure the customers' working capacity and give visibility of inbound, outbound, and on-property cars. These reports are effective tools for the PTRA and their customers to manage inventory levels, plan daily activities, and take action when a fleet is exceeding operating plans.

Additional new reports showing comprehensive outbound blocking and yard blocking information have reduced outbound dwell time by 43% and reduced industry dwell by 26%.

The PTRA and RMI have also been involved in a new project that tracks and displays the exact location of inbound trains on an electronic system map with drill-down capabilities, which is a great help as the operations team plans the day's activity.
